<p>I feel that the OT person needs to sit down with the parent and give feedback. Take more control face to face and supervise these OT students. I feel that the OT students need to have longer prac's because by the time the prac students start (letter informing parent) some OT takes place barely even once a week then say in a month the student prac finishes, I don't think much gets accomplished. I actually achieve more with my child and more routinely over a few quick sessions during the week whether it's 5 to 10 minutes. I don't feel that the prac students have made any major impact in my child's OT development. Also the reports are inaccurate.</p>

<p>More feedback to parents. Telling us what's going on with our child once every 10 wks is really not good enough. We want to know when they are struggling and why they are struggling at the time it occurs. Waiting a whole term to tell us means that if they are behind they are now another 10 wks behind.                  If something really isn't working it needs to be fixed and the help provided ASAP awaiting another term or two to do it isn't good enough. This allows us to get outside help or tell our own OT , speechie , tutor , paed, psych, to implement help/changes                  Also sometimes things inter relate with home these can't be rectified if we aren't notified.                  I really feel feedback is bad. What is a communication book for? A daily date and signature?</p>
<p>I also feel that one EA between years 1,2,3 is ridiculous. Each and every class needs a full time EA as these kids have been put in this school as they need help and they are behind all other kids. Maybe generate a petition for the parents to sign and address a letter to local MP and the education minister.</p>
<p>Perhaps offer workshops on a rotation day. When they are on the same day everytime parents miss all of them</p>

School identity is important yet we are enrolled in one school but wear another schools uniform and many people haven't heard of the LDC so I have to explain what it is and where it is (including mainstream parents at the school just thinking they are special needs kids / classes!!)</p>
